Use / Applications:

It can be used to dilute synthetic or oleo-synthetic enamels, but mainly to dilute fine art paints and for restoration work, to dilute waxes, to remove tar from the bodywork of cars, to clean up oil and grease, for DIY, to clean brushes, etc.

The more or less visible shading is due to the oxidation of turpentine, but it does not affect its quality or use; it rather shows the vegetable origin and purity of the product.

For degreasing, washing and cleaning operations in the bodywork sector, please refer to products that comply with Italian Legislative Decree No. 161 of March 27, 2006.

How to use:

For diluting enamels and colors, add the right amount of turpentine to achieve the right viscosity and drying of oil colors.

When restoring antique furniture and paintings, it is advisable to seek the advice and expertise of the experts in the field.

To clean brushes, palette knives, palettes, etc., wash with turpentine until all traces of color are removed. Then rinse with soap and water to remove any oily residue. Store the brushes with the bristles upwards.
